My understanding was that following the immediate removal of all tobacco product displays, only the remaining supplies of tobacco products were permitted to be sold. That an under-the-counter trade persists fully a year later is disappointing, to say the least.

Next month I have been asked to give the keynote address at Alabama's first statewide conference on reducing morbidity and mortality from tobacco use. I find it sadly ironic that our own hospital appears to be missing a golden opportunity to take a leadership role in this effort.
