PURPOSE: The Emphysema Slims Celebrity Pro Tennis Championship is a national tennis circuit sponsored by DOC, Doctors Cought to Care, a nonprofit group of health professionals, medical students and physicians. The purpose of DOC is to educate the public, particularly teenagers, about the dangers of tobacco, alcohol, and drug abuse. The Emphysema Slims Tournament, now in its fourth year, is designed to offer youth an exciting, healthy, fun alternative to the falsely glamorous lifestyle of cigarettes, alcohol, and all other drugs promoted through advertising. All proceeds from the tournament will be used to further DOC's educational efforts within the Augusta area school systems.

FORMAT: A round robin doubles tournament will take place throughout the day, featuring top junior and adult tennis players in Augusta. The teams will be selected on the basis of the player's self-evaluation in order to insure that the tennis will be as evenly matched as possible. All interested players are encouraged to participate. There will be a maximum number of 16 teams, with the teams being randomly selected and placed into one of four brackets. The winners of each bracket will advance, and the overall winning team will play a special exhibition match.

COSTS: \$10.00 - This includes entrance donation, breakfast, lunch, t-shirt, and reception. All donations are tax deductible.

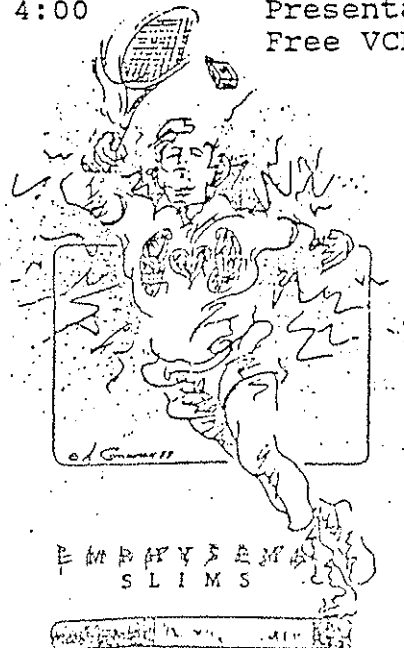

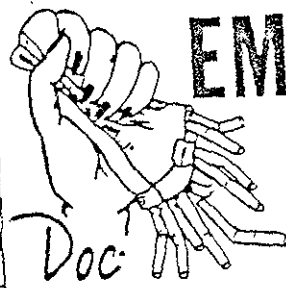
