

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
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

What is Washington DOC?

Washington DOC, a coalition of health care and media activists, uses satire and Madison Avenue pizzazz to promote health by countering the deceitful promotion of tobacco and alcohol.

'Immunizing' Our Children

School Talks: Volunteer physicians, trained by Washington DOC (Doctors Ought to Care), have spoken to thousands of students, "immunizing" them against tobacco and alcohol ads.

Videos: Classrooms around the world have seen video programs produced by Washington DOC, which educate children to see through advertising myths.

Smoking Dolls: Washington DOC is developing "Smokey Joe," a three-foot, interactive smoking doll that shows how a <u>real</u> Marlboro cowboy looks, inside and out.

Washington DOC has conducted an investigation, in cooperation with the Seattle/King County Health Department, which is helping to strengthen laws that prohibit tobacco sales to minors. Washington DOC works with state, county and city governments to develop better laws to restrict sales and promotion of tobacco and alcohol.

Exposing Sports Sponsorships: Tobacco and alcohol companies have no business in sports business.

Washington DOC promoted health, not drugs, by sponsoring the 1989 U.S. Boommerang team and a monstertruck at the 1990 Camel Monstertruck Races.

Washington DOC has been a leader in the fight to keep giant tobacco billboards out of our sports arenas, where the profit motive takes priority over the well-being of our youth.

Countering the Philip Morris Bill of Rights Tour: In protest of Philip Morris'

sponsorship of the Bill of Rights Tour, Washington DOC built the "Statue of Nicotina." The chain-smoking, 15-foot symbol of addiction has followed the nationwide tour, exposing the hypocrisy of tobacco marketing to hundreds of thousands of citizens.

working with hospitals and businesses to

throughout the Pacific Northwest.


